

MEDIA STATEMENT 27 NOVEMBER 2015

PP v LAM LENG HUNG & ORS PROSECUTION APPEALS AGAINST MANIFESTLY INADEQUATE SENTENCES

- 1. The six accused persons in the case of *PP v Lam Leng Hung & Ors* were found guilty and convicted for offences of criminal breach of trust as an agent under Section 409 and falsification of accounts under Section 477A of the Penal Code on 21 October 2015.
- 2. On 20 November 2015, Judicial Commissioner See Kee Oon, Presiding Judge of the State Courts, imposed custodial sentences on the six accused persons. The imprisonment terms range from eight years to 21 months. His full written grounds for these sentences were released on 23 November 2015.
- **3.** Having carefully considered the written grounds, the Prosecution is of the view that the sentences imposed are manifestly inadequate, in all the circumstances of the case. The Prosecution has accordingly filed notices of appeal today, against the sentences imposed on all six accused persons.
