THE APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTOR-GENERAL PANG KHANG CHAU AND

JUDICIAL COMMISSIONERS TO THE HIGH COURT**

“Khang Chau has spent 17 of his 21 years in the Legal Service in AGC, serving with great distinction in both the Civil Division and the International Affairs Division, where he assumed the position of Director-General in 2012. He has played a key role in some of the most significant foreign policy achievements of Singapore in the past decade including our success before the International Court of Justice in the Pedra Branca case, the conclusion and subsequent implementation of the agreement with Malaysia on the return of Malayan Railway land in Singapore as well as the conclusion and signing of the treaty with Indonesia on the maritime boundary between the two countries in the Changi-Batam sector. Khang Chau is greatly respected in both AGC and at the highest levels of the Government for his impressive legal and institutional knowledge, diplomatic acumen and sound advice.

Audrey has been a key member of the AGC senior leadership team. She joined AGC as the 2nd Deputy Parliamentary Counsel in 2012 after more than 17 years in the Supreme Court and the then Subordinate Courts where she served with great distinction and rose to hold the appointment of Deputy Registrar of the Supreme Court. Audrey became Deputy Chief Legislative Counsel in 2013. She has been in charge of law revision and knowledge management in the Legislation Division as well as a law drafting portfolio covering education, population policies, employment and superannuation and court-related legislation. She is highly respected for her forthrightness and commitment to excellence.
